Original Sentence: 366 days custody; 3 years supervised release. Special conditions: (1) Not possess firearms, explosive devices, or other dangerous weapons; (2) drug and alcohol testing/treatment, with co-pay; (3) submit to search of person, property, residence, abode or vehicle; (4) not knowingly associate with activists involved with animal rights or environmental organizations that have a history of violence or condoning violence as a means of protest or demonstration, including but not limited to the Earth Liberation Front and the Animal Liberation Front; and (5) not to publish in print or media or on the Internet any publications for or in relation to The Animal Liberation Front or The Earth Liberation Front or any organization that has a history of violence or that encourages, incites, or calls for illegal activities or violence. \$100.00 Special Assessment.

March 30, 2009: Jurisdiction of both above cases accepted by Chief U.S. District Paul L. Maloney.

June 9, 2009: Summons issued and appearance before Your Honor. Conditions modified to include: (6) shall not personally, or through third parties, access, own, use or possess any type of computers, computer-related devices, or forms of wireless communication without advance written approval; shall be subject to computer monitoring or search; (7) consent to computer monitoring, with payment for same; (8) provide a list of all computers/computer-related devices at residence/employment; (9) travel restricted to Allegan, Berrien, Kalamazoo, Kent, Muskegon, Ottawa, and Van Buren Counties, W/D of Michigan; (10) 6 months electronic monitoring which may include Global Position Satellite technology; (11) no personal, or through third parties, maintain or have a post office box; (12) provide a list of all addresses where mail is received or sent; (13) employment/residence approved in advance; (14) surrender any passports; not apply for new passports; (15) not possess or be primary user of any cellular phone or mobile telecommunications without prior approval. If approval given, must provide number to probation officer and phone must be in defendant's name or another name approved in advance.

December 7, 2009: Defendant's oral motion granted by Your Honor allowing travel to Maple Grove, Minnesota, and denied allowing travel to Portland, Oregon.

June 29, 2010: Defendant's motion to travel outside the district granted by Your Honor allowing travel to Barry County, Michigan. Hearing scheduled by Your Honor for July 22, 2010, to address motion to travel to other counties in Western District of Michigan, Oregon, and Minnesota.

PETITIONING THE COURT

To issue a warrant

The probation officer believes the offender has violated the following conditions of supervision:

VIOLATION NUMBER 1

Special Condition Number 1: “You shall not associate with activists involved with animal rights or environmental organizations that have a history of violence or condoning violence as a means of protest or demonstration, including but not limited to the Earth First!, the Earth Liberation Front and the Animal Liberation Front.”

Mr. Coronado has associated with Michael Roselle, a known environmental activist, who has a history of condoning violence or direct actions as a means of protest or demonstration.

Supporting Evidence and Information for Violation 1

In monitoring Mr. Coronado’s Facebook account, this officer found Michael Roselle to be a “friend” of Mr. Coronado. According to FBI intelligence and a criminal history investigation of Michael Roselle, he is a well-known environmental activist who has a history of condoning direct action and violence as a means of protest or demonstration. A criminal history report shows Mr. Roselle has a prior federal conviction for illegally climbing Mount Rushmore in 1995. Mr. Roselle also has several prior convictions for misdemeanor offenses related to his environmental activism. Available documentation and intelligence indicates Mr. Roselle is a cofounder of Earth First, Rain Forest Action Network (RAN), and the Ruckus Society. According to the FBI, many environmentalists convicted of violent offenses have been associated with both Earth First and the Ruckus Society organizations.

VIOLATION NUMBER 2

Special Condition Number 7: “The defendant shall consent to computer monitoring as directed by the probation officer and shall cooperate with the computer monitoring participant agreement. The defendant shall pay for computer monitoring services as directed by the probation officer.”

Special Condition Number 6: “The defendant shall not personally or through third parties access, own, use, or possess any type or form of computers (hardware or software), computer-related devices, or other forms of wireless communication without the advance written approval of the probation office. Any approved computer/computer-related devices shall be subject to computer monitoring or search.”

Mr. Coronado was directed to use or possess one computer in his home or at his employment unless otherwise authorized by the supervising officer. He was also advised that any approved computer would be monitored through a computer monitoring program and that he was to advise this officer of any other computers he owned, used, or possessed. In March, April, and May 2010, Mr. Coronado utilized an unmonitored computer without advising this officer or obtaining authorization.

Supporting Evidence for Violation Number 2

This officer found Facebook posts from March 14, April 27, and May 3, 2010, showing Mr. Coronado utilized a computer or computer related device to post information on Facebook. According to computer monitoring records, Mr. Coronado’s monitored computer had no data recorded from February 8 to May 10, 2010. In March 2010, Mr. Coronado advised this officer that his computer had crashed and that he was no longer using or accessing the monitored computer.
